BACKGROUND

Paulding's Board of Commissioners and its **Airport Authority** have signed a 20-year lease agreement with a New York investment group named "Propeller Investments" in hopes of turning our small county airport into a commercial terminal that would service passenger flights. This "deal" was signed in secret in November 2012 after Gwinnett County rejected Propeller's proposal to commercialize Briscoe Field in Lawrenceville, GA. This "backdoor" agreement was kept hidden from Paulding County residents until October of 2013, in order to avoid the public opposition similar to what Propeller experienced in Gwinnett. Propeller CEO Brett Smith, has admitted that "Loose lips sink ships"!
